## Errata

BIRTH: 2nd Milton Chandler Dec 23, 1816 \*

DEATH: 2nd Milton Chandler Oct 30; 1816, 9 days . . \*

This transcription of the family bible of Horatio Chandler gives an impossible set of birth and death dates for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Milton Chandler, with the age at death given as 9 days old.

We don't know if the error originates with the original entry in the family bible or in the transcription of that bible.

DEATH: J. M. Jan 12, 1868 \*

There is no family member with the initials J. M. who died 12 January 1868. Researchers for this family generally attribute this entry as being made for Horatio's son Francis Marion Chandler.
