Notes for the Bible of Willis Hiram Chandler 1829–1911 and his son Noah Chandler 1887-1954

This Bible was published in 1874.

Willis Chandler * Also Know As [AKA]: Willis Hiram Chandler 1829–1911, was married 1st on 13 Sept 1852 to Samantha, and he married 2nd on 09 Oct 1885 to Susan Arminda 'Mindy' Dyer 1852–1907.

Mindy Chandler * AKA: Susan Arminda/RMinda 'Mindy' Dyer 1852–1907, married 1st on 31 May 1868 to William Sargent Turnbaugh 1848-1875, and then married 2nd on 09 Oct 1885 to Willis Hiram Chandler 1829–1911.

Children of Willis Hiram's 1st marriage are thought to include: William 1853, Joseph Peter 1854, John Chandler 1855, Mariah 1857, James Hiram 1858, Samuel A 1859, Mary Elizabeth 1861, Lucy A 1863, George Silas 1865, Angeline Zilpah/Zilla 1867, Emery Frank 1868, Willis 1870, Samantha Cordelia 1872, and Liddy/Lydia 1875.

Children of Willis Hiram's 2nd marriage are thought to include: Noah Chandler 1887–1954, and Israel 1889.


Madison Wiley Turnbagh* is not a Chandler descendant, but the child of 'Mindy' Dyer and William Sargent Turnbaugh/Turnbagh/Turnbough. Madison's siblings - William Idy and Nancy Jane are also listed in this bible.

Birth years for Samantha C Chandler 1873/2 * and Irene Chandler 1907/8 * were written over in a different ink at a later date.

Noah Chandler * married Cora Anna Thompson Standley April 7th 1915 according to two separate entries in the Chandler Family Bible, but is listed as 17 April 1915 in the Oregon State Marriage Records. Cora Anna Thompson had been previously married to Oliver Perry Standley with whom she had a daughter – Goldie Irene. Irene is listed in this bible as Irene Chandler 1907/8 *. She was a step-daughter to Noah - not a Chandler descendant. Miles Irvin and William Ray Thompson * are Cora's brothers.

F. A. Oswald * and Mrs. Simpson * have no known association to the Chandler family at this point in time.

Oswald, Lora Anna Chandler, Niles Irvin Thompson, William Ray Thompson, William Chandler born Dec. 17, 1829, Samantha C. Chandler w/o Willis, Mindy Chandler born April 17, 1952. Several children are added: Isarel Chandler 1889, William 1853, Joseph P. 1854, John 1855, Mariah 1857, James H. 1858, Samuel 1859.......

I am writing to find out what has happened to the Bible. Who it might have been given to. This family belongs to my Chandler lineand I would very much like to be in contact with whoever received it, or even ask for it myself.

The Chandlers listed in the Bible are the descendants of John Chandler born ca. 1806 SC (probable son of William & Mary Bates Chandler of Hickman Co., TN). John migrated to MO early 1830, he is in Washington Co., MO in time for the census. His son Willis/William listed above went to OR in the 1880's as did other family members.
